Peace and social justice, topics that fostered general agreement, were the dominant themes. The Golden Rule, (do unto others as you would have others do unto you) which was seen as the root of all positive religious messages, was often highlighted as an ethic that united Jews, Muslims and Christians - it was rare at that time, due perhaps to relatively small populations, for Eastern religion to be represented at events. The conferences aimed, and to a great extent for participants succeeded, in creating a united sense of vision and mission for religion in the late twentieth century. Yet, after several years of interfaith work, I began to realize that I knew as little about Christianity and Islam (not to mention Buddhism, Sikhism and Hinduism) as I had before I began.
