

It should also be observed that the reconvictions recorded at an American penitentiary, do not include the recommitment of its discharged prisoners to any other prison, even where such facts are known. Unless, therefore, the prisoner returns to the identical prison from which he was discharged, it is assumed that he has abstained from crime, although the case may be that, within a week of his liberation, he was committed to the penitentiary of a neighbouring state, no inquiry on that head being instituted. Under these circumstances, nothing can be more calculated to mislead, than such a test of the effects of imprisonment. The Legislature has placed the general supervision of the penitentiaries, in the hands of a certain number of inspectors. Their powers, which, however, are more nominal than real, differ in the several States, and are defined in the descriptions given of the several penitentiaries in the Appendix. The keeper or agent has nothing whatever to do with the management of finance accounts. The clerk on whom these du/ties devolve, is appointed by the Governor of the State or the inspectors, and is entirely independent of the agent.
